Skilled Physical Therapy Application of Guidelines Range of Motion: Only the qualified physical therapist may perform range of motion tests and, therefore, such tests are skilled physical therapy. Range of motion exercises constitute skilled physical therapy only if they are part of actual treatment for a specific disease state

Medicare Part B Documentation Requirements
What are the Medicare documentation requirements for physical and occupational therapy? Medicare reimburses therapists when the documentation and claim forms accurately report the provision of medically necessary covered services. So, in addition to being legible and relevant, documentation must defend the services a therapist bills.
