Myositis (polymyositis and dermatomyositis) Myositis is a rare condition that affects the muscles. The term myositis means "inflammation of the muscles". The main signs are muscle weakness, painful or aching muscles, tripping or falling, and extreme tiredness after walking or standing.

Dermatomyositis in adults has been linked to an increased likelihood of developing cancer, particularly of the cervix, lungs, pancreas, breasts, ovaries and gastrointestinal tract. Risk of cancer increases with age, although it appears to level off three years or so after a diagnosis of dermatomyositis.

These diseases cause swelling and tenderness in the muscles (polymyositis) and sometimes the skin (dermatomyositis).

Polymyositis is a type of chronic inflammation of the muscles related to dermatomyositis and inclusion body myositis. Its name means "inflammation of many muscles". The inflammation of polymyositis is mainly found in the endomyisial layer of skeletal muscle, whereas dermatomyositis is characterized primarily by inflammation of the perimysial layer of skeletal muscles.

Polymyositis (pol-e-my-o-SY-tis) is an uncommon inflammatory disease that causes muscle weakness affecting both sides of your body. Having this condition can make it difficult to climb stairs, rise from a seated position, lift objects or reach overhead. Polymyositis most commonly affects adults in their 30s, 40s or 50s.

Polymyositis And Dermatomyotosis

Polymyositis and dermatomyositis (PM/DM) are chronic inflammatory diseases of muscle. Muscle weakness is the most common symptom of PM/DM. The cause of PM/DM is unknown. Diagnosis of PM/DM involves physical examination of muscle strength, blood tests for muscle enzymes, electrical tests of muscle and nerves, and is confirmed by muscle biopsy.
